# Hometown Heroes Banners

--The banners are 24" wide and 48" high and will be located on streets throughout the City.

--Banners will be displayed yearly from Memorial Day through Veterans Day.

--Cost of sponsorship for families, individuals, civic organizations, and businesses is \$200.
