

JFK Pool Available for Parties in 2023



When is the pool available?

Any day from 12:00 to 6:00 PM in 4 hour blocks.
The pool will be open to the public during this time.

What is the cost?

There is a \$175 reservation fee for the Pavilion with electricity that is due at time of booking.

There is an additional fee of \$1.50 per child, and \$2.50 per adult. There is no additional fee for season pass holders. A guest list must be provided one week prior to the rental. You will only be charged for those in attendance.

The seating at the Pavilion is limited to 60 people.

*There will be NO refunds issued; you have the option to select a rain date if you choose.

What about food and drink?

You are allowed to bring your own food and drinks.

There are NO grills or glass containers allowed.

In addition, the JFK Concession Stand is open on a daily basis from noon until 6:30 PM.

How can I reserve a date?

To reserve a date, you must call the pool office at 570-622-4299.

Payment is due at time of booking to reserve your date.

Prior to opening day, please email JFKRecComplex@gmail.com for availability.

Please Remember:

- Follow ALL facility rules
- Remove all decorations and litter/trash before leaving the party area. If you bring your own decorations, please use string to hang them up. NO tape, tacks or pins.
- NO grills or glass containers
- NO alcohol or use of nicotine products. NO smoking or vaping is allowed in the pool area.

JFK is available for PRIVATE EVENING Rentals

- Cost is \$275 for 2 hours from 7:00-9:00 PM or \$350 for 3 hours from 7:00-10:00 PM.
- The pool will be cleared 15 minutes prior to the conclusion of your rental

*There will be NO refunds issued; you have the option to select a rain date if you choose.

- Four lifeguards will be on duty. There will be an additional charge of \$30 if a lifeguard is needed at the baby pool.
- You can bring your own food and drink, but NO grills, glass containers, or alcohol
- Limit of 100 people, larger parties will need to be discussed with the pool manager
